MODULE 4 | GMP+ AND HACCP IN THE FEED SECTOR

GMP+ is a quality standard for management of feed safety of all stages and activities around animal feed. Changes in an organization or new activities of the organization can cause that employees build up knowledge of GMP+. The GMP+ website is often referred to in order to find information about the GMP+ standard. At this website one sees the A, B, C and D documents, standards and various annexes, newsletters, EWS, legislation and publications. For interpreting these documents and implementing the requirements it is useful to know the backgrounds and how the scheme works.

The depth of the HACCP system determines the extent to which companies are exposed to the risk of feed safety crises. The hazard analysis and risk assessment are part of the coverage of product liability. How to set up a proper risk assessment in the feed sector? Moreover, in practice also the strength of the evidence on which the risk assessment is based is of great importance when a feed safety crisis arises.
