SFR is (with 85 employees) international, independent and the leading institute in the field of animal nutrition. At present, approximately 9% of the global compound feed industry uses the SFR raw material tables and feed standards. About 54% of our activities are international, with a focus on Europe and S/E-Asia. In the past 7 years an average growth of 5% turnover per year has been achieved. ## RESEARCHER SWINE NUTRITION

The R&D department consists of 20 employees. They are experts in poultry, cattle and pig nutrition and are supported by research assistants and biotechnicians. Our advanced research facilities allow us to conduct experiments, from a scientific, practical and commercial point of view. Our facilities are also suitable for smaller scale experiments, such as health, wellbeing, and digestion studies. SFR works closely together with the animal feed industry and translates fundamental research into practical application.
